
Crossword Puzzle

The Ministry of the Lord Jesus

- Lesson Nineteen -

The Ministry of Revelation – The Lord's Transfiguration

I. Overview.

n this lesson we see how the Lord Jesus revealed Himself in a glorious way to three of His disciples. The Lord Jesus had been with the disciples for three years. In that time they had seen Him do many powerful miracles and speak marvelous words of wisdom. But one day, the Lord Jesus took Peter, James and John up to the top of a mountain. On the top of the mountain, He was glorified before them in a magnificent way. This glorification is called His "transfiguration."



The Lord Jesus took three disciples to the top of a high mountain.

The Lord's face shone with the glory of God and His clothes became brilliant white. Moses and Elijah also appeared with Him in glory. Peter foolishly said that he would make tents for the Lord and Moses and Elijah. The Father overshadowed them with a cloud and spoke from the heavens "This is My Son, the Beloved, in whom I have found My delight. Hear Him!" When the disciples looked up, only Jesus alone was there.

II. Memory Verse.

"This is My Son, the Beloved, in whom I have found My delight. Hear Him!"

III. Lesson.

Before the Lord Jesus went to the cross, He walked with His disciples for three and a half years. They mainly knew Him as the Son of Man. This means that they knew Him as a man. He was the most wonderful man they had ever met, a perfect man, a God-man. They saw His unblemished virtues of love, patience, compassion, mercy and humility, day after day. Often the Lord Jesus revealed to them His divine attributes, by healing diseases and even raising the dead. By these things, His disciples understood that He was God.

Jesus Reveals That He is God by His Transfiguration

Although Jesus had shown His disciples that He is God through many works of power, when He took three disciples up to the top of a mountain, He revealed that He is God in His very Person. When the Lord was at the top of the mountain with His disciples, He was transfigured, or changed, before them. The Lord's face began to shine like the sun. His garments became "as white as light." The disciples were frightened. They were beholding the Lord Jesus in glory.

For the Lord to be revealed in His glory meant that the

life of God was being expressed through the Lord's transfigured or changed body. God had always been hidden in Jesus, only being truly evident through the marvelous works of power that He did. But now God was being expressed through the Lord Jesus' entire being.

Moses and Elijah also appeared with the Lord Jesus, talking to Him. Peter, foolishly putting

Moses and Elijah on the same level as the Lord Jesus, told the Lord that they would build three tabernacles or tents for them. Just then, the Father overshadowed them all in a cloud. He spoke from the heavens "This is My Son, the Beloved, in whom I have found my delight. Hear Him!"

The Father came in to make such a statement to show that only Jesus was on the highest level. He clearly spoke about Jesus being the very Son of God in glory – even God Himself. When the Father had finished speaking, only Jesus remained with the disciples. Moses and Elijah were certainly not on the same level with Jesus. Only He is the glorious Son of God.
